NRP and other basic principles of golden hour management.

Station B- Resp Support – 1: Noninvasive ventilation

Station A- Procedures in Neonatology

Hands on training on all emergency and elective procedures like endotracheal intubation, chest tube insertion, central line (UVC, UAC, PICC lines) insertion, exchange transfusion etc

Station B- Neonatal Screening

Metabolic screening (TMS) and its interpretations, OAE and ROP screening, screening for congenital heart diseases, interpretation of growth charts.

Station C- Infection control practices in NICU

Hand washing techniques, Aseptic Non-touch techniques (ANTT protocol), Bundle care approach for invasive procedures and VAP prevention, protocol for HAI screening etc.

Station D- Therapeutic hypothermia and management of perinatal asphyxia

Definition, indication, procedure of therapeutic hypothermia in low income countries. Use of phase changing materials in providing TH. Monitoring and troubleshooting the baby on TH.

Station E- Point of Care Ultrasonography (POCUS) in newborn (Part-1)-Functional echocardiography

Yes! Ultrasound probe is the new generation stethoscope.in this station we will learn about basic echo views. Functional echo, assessment of PDA and PPHN, assessment of the volume status of the baby etc.

Station F- Point of Care Ultrasonography (POCUS) in newborn (Part- 2)-Neurosonogram

Basic views, assessment of IVH, ventricular dilation, congenital anomalies and doppler studies.
